BACK IN TIME

1837 – Andrew Petrie and his family arrived in Brisbane

1847 – The paddle steamer *Sovereign* out of Brisbane ran aground on the bar between Moreton and Stradbroke Islands.

1857 – 2nd Lieutenant Fredrick Wheeler of the Native Mounted Police set up headquarters in Sandgate

The Duncan, Stewart and Carseldine families settled at Bald Hills.
